As early as the sixteenth century, Germans played a bluffing game called "Pochen." It later developed into a French version, 1 called "Poque," which was eventually brought

over to New Orleans and played on the riverboats that plied the Mississippi.

In the

1830s, the game was refined further and became known as Poker. During the Civil War, the key rule about drawing 1 card to improve one's hand was added. A variation - Stud Poker - appeared at about the same time. There are hundreds of versions of Poker, and the game is played not only in private homes, but also in countless 1 Poker rooms at famous casinos. Poker can be played socially for pennies or matchsticks, or professionally for thousands of dollars.

There is plenty of luck in Poker, but the game requires incredibly great skill as well, and each player is the 1 master of his own fate.

The Pack

The standard 52-card pack, sometimes with the addition of one or two jokers, is used. 1 Poker is a one-pack game, but today, in virtually all games played in clubs and among the best players, two 1 packs of contrasting colors are utilized in order to speed up the game. While one pack is being dealt, the 1 other is being shuffled and prepared for the next deal. The procedure for two packs is as follows: While the 1 deal is in progress, the previous dealer assembles all the cards from the pack he dealt, shuffles them, and places 1 them to the left. When it is time for the next deal, the shuffled deck is passed to the next 1 dealer. In many games in which two packs are used, the dealer's left-hand opponent, instead of the right-hand opponent, cuts 1 the pack.

In clubs, it is customary to change cards often and to permit any player to call for new cards 1 whenever they wish. When new cards are introduced, both packs are replaced, and the seal and cellophane wrapping on the 1 new decks should be broken in full view of all the players.

Card Values/scoring

While Poker is played in innumerable forms, a 1 player who understands the values of the Poker hands and the principles of betting can play without difficulty in any 1 type of Poker game. Except in a few versions of the game, a Poker hand consists of five cards. The 1 various combinations of Poker hands rank from five of a kind (the highest) to no pair or nothing (the lowest):

Five 1 of a Kind – This

is the highest possible hand and can occur only in games where at least one 1 card is wild, such as a joker, the two one-eyed jacks, or the four deuces. Examples of five of a 1 kind would be four 10s and a wild card or two queens and three wild cards.

Straight

Flush – This is 1 the highest possible hand when only the standard pack is used, and there are no wild cards. A straight flush 1 consists of five cards of the same suit in sequence, such as 10, 9, 8, 7, 6 of hearts. The 1 highest-ranking straight flush is the A, K, Q, J, and 10 of one suit, and this combination has a special 1 name: a royal flush or a royal straight flush. The odds on being dealt this hand are 1 in almost 1 650,000.

Four of a Kind – This is the next highest hand, and it ranks just below a straight flush. An 1 example is four aces or four 3s. It does not matter what the fifth, unmatched card is.

Full House – This 1 colorful hand is made up of three cards of one rank and two cards of another rank, such as three 1 8s and two 4s, or three aces and two 6s.

Flush – Five cards, all of the same suit, but not 1 all in sequence, is a flush. An example is Q, 10, 7, 6, and 2 of clubs.

Straight – Five cards 1 in sequence, but not all of the same suit is a straight. An example is 9, 8, 7, 6, 5.

Three 1 of a Kind –

This combination contains three cards of the same rank, and the other two cards each of 1 a different rank, such as three jacks, a seven, and a four.

Two Pairs – This hand

contains a pair of 1 one rank and another pair of a different rank, plus any fifth card of a different rank, such as Q, 1 Q, 7, 7, 4.

One Pair – This frequent combination

contains just one pair with the other three cards being of 1 different rank. An example is 10, 10, K, 4, 3.

No Pair – This very common hand contains "nothing." None of 1 the

five cards pair up, nor are all five cards of the same suit or consecutive in rank.

When more 1 than one player has no pair, the hands are rated by the highest card each hand contains, so that an 1 ace-high hand beats a king-high hand, and so on.

Two hands

that are identical, card for card, are tied since the 1 suits have no relative rank in Poker. In such a case, the tied players split the pot. Note that if 1 two hands contain the same high pair, then the ranking of the next card in the hands determines which one 1 wins. For example: 9, 9, 7, 4, 2 beats 9, 9, 5, 3, 2. Likewise, two hands that have identical 1 pairs would be decided by the fifth card. For example: Q, Q, 6, 6, J beats Q, Q, 6, 6, 1 10.

Betting

Betting is the key to Poker, for the game, in essence, is a game of chip management.

In the course of 1 each Poker deal, there will be one or more betting intervals in which the players have an opportunity to bet 1 on their hands. Minimizing losses with poor hands and maximizing winnings with good hands is the underlying skill that Poker 1 requires.

Before the cards are even dealt, the rules of the Poker game being played may require that each player put 1 an initial contribution, called an "ante," of one or more chips into the pot, to start it off.

Each betting interval, 1 or round,

begins when a player, in turn, makes a bet of one or more chips. Each player to the 1 left, in turn, must either "call" that bet by putting into the pot the same number of chips; or "raise," 1 which means that the player puts in more than enough chips to call; or "drop" ("fold"), which means that the 1 player puts no chips in the pot, discards their hand, and is out of the betting until the next deal.

When 1 a player drops, they

lose any chips that have put into that pot. Unless a player is willing to put 1 into the pot at least as many chips as any preceding player, they must drop out.

A betting

interval ends when 1 the bets have been equalized - that is, when each player has either put in exactly as many chips as 1 their predecessors or has dropped. There are usually two or more betting intervals for each Poker deal. After the final 1 interval there is a "showdown," which means that each player who remains shows their hand face up on the table. 1 The best Poker hand then takes the pot.

If a player makes a bet or a raise that

no other player 1 calls, they win the pot without showing their hand. Thus, in Poker, there is a bluffing element, and the best 1 combination of cards does not always win the pot! Bluffing is one of the key reasons why Poker is so 1 popular.

If a player wishes to

remain in the game without betting, they "check." This means, in effect, that the player 1 is making a "bet of nothing." A player may check provided no one before them in that betting interval has 1 made a bet. If another player has bet, they cannot check but

must at least call the bet or drop. 1 A player who checks may raise a bet that has been raised by another player. This is called "sandbagging," which 1 is allowed, unless it has been decided beforehand that this practice is forbidden. If all players check during a round 1 of play, the betting interval is over, and all the players still in the pot remain in the game.

In each 1 betting round, one player is designated as the first bettor, according to the rules of the game. The turn to 1 bet always moves to the left, from player to player, and no one may check, bet, or even drop, except 1 when it is their turn.

Knowing When to Bet

The ranking of Poker hands is based on mathematics. The less likely a 1 player is to get a certain hand, the higher it ranks and the more likely it is to win the 1 pot. For example, a player should not expect to be dealt a straight flush more than once in 65,000 hands, 1 but they can expect to be dealt two pair about once in every 21 hands.

Unless a player is planning to 1 bluff, they should not make a bet without holding a hand that they think may be the best. No Poker 1 player can bet intelligently unless they know what constitutes a good hand, a fair hand, and a bad hand. A 1 table of the various Poker hands and the number of combinations of each in a pack of cards is provided.

The 1 Kitty

By unanimous or majority agreement, the players may establish a special fund called a "kitty." Usually the kitty is built 1 up by "cutting" (taking) one low-denomination chip from each pot in which there is more than one raise. The kitty 1 belongs to all the players equally, and it is used to pay for new decks of cards or for food 1 and drinks. Any chips left in the kitty when the game ends are divided equally among the players who are 1 still in the game. Unlike the rule in some other games, such as Pinochle, when a player leaves a Poker 1 game before it ends, they are not entitled to take their share of chips that comprised part of the kitty.

Chips

Poker 1 is almost always played with poker chips. For a game with seven or more players, there should be a supply 1 of at least 200 chips. Usually, the white chip (or the lightest-colored chip) is the unit, or lowest-valued chip, worth 1 whatever the minimum ante or bet is; a red chip (or some other colored chip) is worth five whites, and 1 a blue chip (or some other dark-colored chip) is worth 10 or 20 or 25 whites or two, four or 1 five reds. At the start of the game, each player "buys in" by purchasing a certain number of chips. All 1 of the players usually buy in for the same amount.

Banker

One player should be designated as the banker, who keeps the 1 stock of chips and records how many have been issued to each player or how much cash the player has 1 paid for their chips. Players should make no private transactions or exchanges among themselves; a player with surplus chips may 1 return them to the banker and receive credit or cash for them, while a player who wants more chips should 1 obtain them only from the banker.

Betting Limits

There are different ways of fixing a betting limit.

Some limit is necessary; otherwise 1 a player with a lot more money would have, or would be perceived to have, an unfair advantage. Once fixed, 1 the limit should be unalterable throughout the game unless the players unanimously agree to change the stakes. Some popular limit 1 systems follow:

Fixed Limit

No one may bet or raise by more than a stipulated number of chips, for example, two, or five, or 10. Usually this limit varies with the stage of the game: In Draw Poker, if the limit is five before the draw, it might be ten after the draw. In Stud Poker, if the limit is five in the first four betting intervals, it is 10 in the final betting interval (and often ten whenever a player has a pair or better showing).

Pot Limit

Any bet or raise is limited to the number of chips in the pot at that time. This means that a player who raises may count as part of the pot the number of chips required for the player to call. If there are six chips in the pot, and a bet of four is made, the total is 10 chips; it requires four chips for the next player to call, making 14; and the player may then raise by 14 chips. But even when the pot limit is played, there should be some maximum limit, such as 50 chips.

Table Stakes

The limit for each player is the number of chips the player has in front of them. If the player has only 10 chips, they may bet no more than 10 and he may call any other player's bet to that extent. In table stakes, no player may withdraw chips from the table, or return chips to the banker, until they leave the game. A player may add to their stack, but only between the deal just completed and the beginning of the next deal.

Whangdoodles, or Roodles

In a fixed-limit game, it is often agreed that following any very good hand - a full house or better, for example - there will be one deal by each player of Jackpots, in which everyone antes double, and the betting limit is doubled for these deals as well.

Poverty 1 Poker

A maximum limit is put on the number of chips any player may lose. Each takes out one stack at the start; if they lose that stack, the banker issues the player another, without charging for it, and in many cases, the player can get still a third stack free before dropping out of the game. (Some limit should be placed on the number of free stacks so that a player will have the incentive to play carefully.)

No Limit

In these sessions, the "sky's the limit," but such games are rarely played today.

Limits on Raises

In almost all games played today, there is a limit on the number of raises at each betting interval, and this limit is invariably three raises.

Draw & Stud Poker

The players should first decide what form of Poker they will play

The main forms of Poker are Draw Poker and Stud Poker. In Draw Poker, all the cards are dealt face down to the players. In Stud Poker, some of the cards are dealt face up as the betting progresses, so that all of the other players get to see a part of each player's hands.

Unless the host, or the

rule of a club, has already established the game, the players should first decide what form of Poker they will play. Two factors should influence their decision: the number of players, and whether the group has only experienced players or has some inexperienced players. The following selections are recommended:

2, 3 or 4 players:

Stud Poker in any form. Usually, with so few players, only the very experienced play Draw 1 Poker and they will often use a stripped deck, which is a pack with cards removed, such as all the 1 deuces (twos) and treys (threes).

5—8 players: Any form of Poker, either Draw or Stud.

9 or 10 players: Five-card Stud Poker

More than 10 players: One of

the games in which fewer than five cards are dealt, such as Three-Card Monte or

1 Spit-in-the-Ocean. All of the Poker variations are described later in this chapter.

Another alternative with so many players is to simply form two tables and organize two separate games.

Dealer's Choice

When the Poker session is Dealer's Choice, each dealer

has the 1 privilege of naming the form of Poker to be played and to designate the ante,

wild cards (if any), and 1 the maximum limit of chips that can be wagered during each

round. However, the dealer may not require one player 1 to ante more than another. If a

game such as Jackpots is selected and no one opens the betting, the 1 same dealer deals again and everyone antes again.

Wild Cards

While most Poker purists choose to play with

no wild cards, in 1 many games, especially Dealer's Choice, various cards may be

designated as wild. A wild card is specified by the holder 1 to be a card of any rank or

suit, such as a fifth queen, or the card needed to combine 1 with the other four in a

player's hand to form a straight or a flush. Wild cards in a Poker 1 game add variety,

and of course, they greatly increase the chances of getting a rare combination such as

a full 1 house or a straight flush. The usual choices for wild cards are as follows:

The

Joker

Note that most packs of cards 1 include two jokers for use in such games as

Canasta. Poker players are increasingly adding one or both jokers as 1 wild cards.

The

Bug

This is the joker, but its wildness is limited: It counts as an ace; or as a card

1 of any suit for making a flush; or as a card of any rank and suit for making a straight

1 or straight flush.

Deuces

"Deuces Wild" is a popular form of Draw Poker. Every two is

wild. Sometimes the joker is included 1 as a fifth wild card. Note that the number of

wild cards in a hand does not diminish it in 1 anyway; thus, with deuces wild, five of a

kind comprised of 10, 10, 2, 2, 2 (five 10s) beats 8, 1 8, 8, 8, 2 (five 8s).

One-Eyed

Cards

The king of diamonds and the jacks of spades and hearts show only one 1 eye,

whereas the other face cards all have two eyes. One-eyed jacks are sometimes designated

as wild cards, but the 1 king of diamonds is rarely selected to be wild.

Low Hole Card

In

Stud Poker, each player's lowest "hole" card (that is, 1 the lowest card that is dealt

face down and not seen by the other players) is wild. In Draw Poker, 1 the wild card

would be the lowest card in a player's hand. When such a card is designated, it means

1 that every card of that rank in that player's hand is wild, but the fact that a certain

card is 1 wild in one player's hand does not make that same rank of card wild in other

players' hands.

Laws and Ethics

In 1 every game, a written code of Poker laws should be used as the final arbiter for settling all questions. No 1 Poker laws are universally followed - there are many local customs and preferences - but the Poker laws on this 1 site embrace the latest customs of the most expert games and are recommended for adoption. It is a tradition of 1 Poker that any club or group of players may make special rules, called "house rules," to suit their personal preferences. 1 Of course, any such house rules should be written down.

Time Limit

Before play begins, the players should set a time limit 1 for when the game ends and stick to it. Violation of this principle could eventually turn pleasant sessions into unpleasant 1 ones. Often when the time for quitting is approaching, the host or one of the players will say "three more 1 deals" or "through Zane's deal," so that players will know how many deals are left and can gauge their strategies 1 accordingly.

E F Nancy Valverde foi repetidamente presa pelo departamento de polícia Los Angeles por usar roupas masculinas. Quando ela morreu, aos 92 anos a cidade tinha nomeado uma praça jackpot diamonds jackpot diamonds honra seu primeiro monumento público para lésbica Valverde, uma orgulhosa lésbica butch Chicana sábia que se recusou a cumprir as normas sociais mesmo nos anos 1940 e 50 quando o racista da cidade força policial homofóbica frequentemente preso pessoas sob leis anti-mascaradas "que criminalizou por usar roupas oficiais julgado ser inadequado para seu gênero. "Eles queriam que eu fosse outra pessoa. Eu não poderia ser mais alguém, esta sou mim", disse Valverde jackpot diamonds um pequeno documentário sobre jackpot diamonds vida ". Enquanto os estados dos EUA aprovam leis que criminalizavam as performances de drag e proibindo a saúde com afirmação por gênero para jovens trans, o combate da Valverde contra assédio policial parece profundamente relevante", disse Gregorio Davila jackpot diamonds seu documentário LA: A Queer History. Valverde tornou-se um ícone queer de Los Angeles por seus esforços iniciais e resistência, recusando esconder quem ela era mesmo jackpot diamonds uma época na qual muitas pessoas tinham medo da homossexualidade. Durante décadas, lésbicas butch e outras pessoas que não estão jackpot diamonds conformidade com o gênero poderiam ser presas por suas escolhas de roupas. Frustrada por ser repetidamente presa e condenada sob leis anti-crossdressing que datam do

século XIX, Valverde disse à historiadora Lillian Faderman : “Ela foi para a biblioteca de direito jackpot diamonds 1959” E descobriu Que os tribunais haviam decidido realmente Em 1950 – uma mulher não estava infringindo A lei simplesmente Por usar roupas masculinas.

Com pessoas LGBTQ+ nos EUA enfrentando uma onda renovada de ataques políticos, Los Angeles fez um monumento público à luta da Valverde contra o assédio policial.

Em junho de 2024, menos do que um ano antes da morte Valverde's a cidade oficial renomeou uma interseção centro-centro o Cooper Do Nuts / Nancy Valverde Square. O nome presta homenagem tanto para Valverde que frequentou escola e foi preso lá; Eo local é popular com pessoas gays ou trans (a qual se acredita ser onde está localizada) jackpot diamonds 1958-1959 batalha pré Stonewall contra assédio policial

Los Angeles nomeou uma praça jackpot diamonds homenagem a Nancy Valverde, seu primeiro monumento público para lésbicas.

Na cerimônia de dedicação, a polícia fez um pedido formal para desculpas com Ruby Flores primeira vice-chefe do departamento na Latina dizendo: "Estes maus trato dos nossos cidadãos estavam errado e nunca deveriam ter acontecido".

Valverde era frágil demais para comparecer pessoalmente, mas jackpot diamonds reação à honra de acordo com Marisol Sanchez coordenadora dos serviços residentes nos apartamentos LGBTQ+ onde ele morava foi: "Eu nunca pensei que eu iria conseguir isso.

Confrontos com a polícia

As pessoas que conheciam Valverde descrevem seu charme e senso de humor, bem como o espírito lutador. "Todo mundo conhecia Nancy", disse Sanchez. "E se você não conhecesse a Nancy ela iria dar-se conta".

Mesmo nos últimos anos de Valverde, quando ela tinha menos energia "que não tirou o atrevimento dela", acrescentou Sanchez.

Nancy Valverde nasceu jackpot diamonds 1932 e mudou-se para Los Angeles quando criança.

Enquanto Valverde é às vezes referida agora como um exemplo de uma ativista LGBTQ, não era assim que ela se descreveria. "Ela estava tentando fazer declarações políticas", disse Davila o diretor do documentário “ela fez a diferença apenas por ser quem foi”.

Valverde nasceu jackpot diamonds 1932 no Novo México e mudou-se com jackpot diamonds família para East Los Angeles quando criança. Ela começou a trabalhar aos 11 anos, primeiro escolhendo damascos de algodão ; depois trabalhando num restaurante - entregando doces numa padaria – ela experimentou discriminação tanto como chicana durante os últimos tempos que o município estava destruindo um bairro mexicano americano quanto forçando famílias na construção do Dodger Stadium (estádio), mas também lésbicas...

Durante a Segunda Guerra Mundial, muitas mulheres assumiram novos papéis no local de trabalho enquanto os homens estavam lutando fora do país. Mas depois da guerra "houve um verdadeiro impulso para levar as pessoas à jackpot diamonds posição 'normal'", disse Faderman ao historiador The Guardian: "O lesbianismo tornou-se particularmente ameaçador com essa motivação".

O chefe da polícia de Los Angeles, William H. Parker que era bem conhecido por suas opiniões racistas sobre as comunidades negras e latinas tornou um campeão desse esforço - disse Faderman usando o poder policial para invadir bares gays ou reprimir qualquer sinal público do homossexualismo."[215]

O resultado foi um departamento de polícia com poderes para assediar, prender e até mesmo aprisionar pessoas "à vontade", disse Faderman. Um dos autores do livro Gay LA: A History of Sexual Outlaws (Lamentações Sexuais), Power Politics [Política da Potência] and Lipstick Lesbian(S) que diz ser preso por comportamento homossexual pode ter graves consequências sociais ou profissionais; mulheres correm o risco ainda mais alto jackpot diamonds perder a guarda das crianças

Ainda assim, dentro do abrigo de bares gays e "vestimentas duras", como eram chamados na comunidade negra tentou encontrar maneiras para expressar suas identidades.

Em São Francisco, uma mulher lembrou-se de arregaçar as algemas da calça e usar um longo casaco feminino para que no caminho do bar gay ela parecesse estar usando saia", disse Kate Redburn. Outra butch "pensou jackpot diamonds ficar segura porque costurou rendas nas meias", diz Faderman

Embora houvesse muitas lésbicas de butch na década dos 1950, a maioria delas "tinha medo realmente desafiar os policiais se fossem assediadas ou presas", disse Faderman.

Valverde sabia desde cedo que não era exatamente como outras meninas. "Eu só soube me sentir confortável jackpot diamonds calças, roupas masculinas", disse ela a Davila Ela diz ainda ter aprendido o termo 'lébio' até ir para cadeia

Durante anos após jackpot diamonds primeira prisão, aos 17 e Valverde lembrou que enfrentou tratamento severo jackpot diamonds público perante o tribunal ou na cadeia onde se recordou de cumprir uma sentença por três meses para mascarar. Ao longo do tempo ela lutou contra isso!

Quando os policiais costumavam dizer a ela: "Eu quero vê-la de vestido", dizia para eles, que se sentavam e esperavam porque você ia ficar cansado. Valverde disse ao Faderman; Os oficiais traziam as roupas usadas por ele como prova no tribunal... E diziam coisas do tipo "É melhor eu não brincar com minha esposa".

Quando ela estava frequentando a escola no centro de Los Angeles para se tornar barbeiro, Valverde disse que os policiais iriam prendê-la na sexta e não deixá-lo sair até segunda pela manhã. O chefe da faculdade exigiu saber por quê sempre atrasou -e teve mesmo o dever explicar isso porque era só uma festa mas sim um momento jackpot diamonds jackpot diamonds prisão!

"Eu só sabia que estava confortável jackpot diamonds calças, roupas masculinas", disse Valverde.

Em um ponto, Valverde foi colocada jackpot diamonds uma seção de solidariedade masculina da prisão e o policial tentou apalpá-la. Ela disse no documentário do Davil que ela começou tambores na bancada dentro dela cela exigindo ver as policiais mulheres quando se queixou ao lado daquela célula; apresentou Nancy vinda dos Estados Unidos para explicar tudo aquilo ocorrido: os homens nas células à jackpot diamonds volta também estavam Chicano (eles logo foram)

Valverde nem sempre conseguiu esse tipo de apoio. "A comunidade gay não me queria por perto", disse ela a Davila."Eles disseram que eu estava muito fora, todo mundo passava direto e o único lugar jackpot diamonds onde eles saíam era nos bares nas ruas... [medo] Eu os tornaria culpados pela associação".

Um legado poderoso

Valverde, que criou várias crianças adotivas e permaneceu como membro ativo das comunidades gays de Los Angeles ao longo da vida. Ela se lembra participando jackpot diamonds uma dos primeiros Dyke Marches na cidade "quando éramos apenas cerca 75 pessoas". Eu pensei: 'Finalmente chegou justiça!', disse ela à Davila ironicamente!

Alguns jovens gays Angelenos lembram-se da barbearia como um lugar de refúgio. Um homem idoso já teve seu primeiro corte com Nancy, disse Sanchez e o cara lembrou: "Eu sabia que ela era diferente; eu soube dela ser uma área segura quando nem tinha admitido para mim mesmo a minha condição gay".

Nas últimas décadas de jackpot diamonds vida, Valverde mudou-se para o Triangle Square Apartments. O primeiro desenvolvimento habitacional acessível aos idosos LGBTQ+ nos EUA e adorou a comunidade que se sentia muito defensiva com isso - disse Sanchez lá encontrou amor novamente jackpot diamonds seus 80 anos encontrando seu parceiro Andi (que também foi morar no prédio).

Valverde também se tornou uma importante anciã latina para as gerações mais jovens de artistas, escritores e cineastas que compartilharam jackpot diamonds história através dos documentários pesquisa acadêmica "Ensaio" (The Barber of East LA) da Raquel Gutiérrez. Hoje, a história de Valverde está assumindo uma nova urgência à medida que os legisladores republicanos passam novas leis visando pessoas transgênero e gays. Em 2024 o ano jackpot diamonds Nancy foi dedicado Praça valverde mais do 12 estados introduziram as legislações proibindo performances drags ; Tennessee Montana Flórida Texas passou por eles Embora a "linguagem jurídica literal" das novas proibições de arrastar não seja o mesmo que as leis centenárias banindo mascaradas, "vem do tipo semelhante pânico sobre gênero e sexualidade", disse Redburn.

Embora muitas das proibições de arrastar estejam ligadas a desafios legais, o projeto teve um "efeito calmante", segundo Joshua Block advogado da União Americana pelas Liberdades Civis que deixou as pessoas LGBTQ+ se sentindo sob ataque e vigilância.

Em seus últimos anos, Valverde disse que estava orgulhosa dos "jovens trabalhando para abrir a sociedade", mas era cética jackpot diamonds relação à grande conversa e postura.

Especialmente numa luta longe de terminar jackpot diamonds mensagem hoje: "Coloque seu traseiro no fogo da maneira como fizemos – arrisquem o rabo".
